5. Ratepayer Matters Subcommittee

The subcommittee met on the afternoon of Monday, 9th September and the following items were discussed:

• A joint initiative between TDC and KCA to work with skilled volunteers to undertake work in the Domain to improve drainage after heavy rain. This work is already underway.

- KCA is enjoying a healthy and mutually beneficial connection and engagement with TDC now
- TDC Long Term Plan. Our submission was well received and was one of many with concerns regarding proposed changes to how waste management is undertaken at Kinloch. It has been reassuring to know no changes will be made at this time.
- KCA will continue to be involved in supporting safety and security initiatives at Kinloch
- KCA remains involved and informed regarding Henry Halls Commercial Plans at Kinloch

Ongoing discussion and awareness of various other issues involving Kinloch including Resource Consent Applications; allocation of Developer Contribution Funds; future use and development of the hall at Kinloch; boat servicing options at Kinloch; Seven Oaks submission hearings; Wastewater and Water concerns; and Kinloch roads, reserves and pathways

• Kinloch Stream Reserves Report

Over 5000 plants have been planted in the last month in the Whangamata and the Okaia Streams. More plants are still there to be collected. Would like to make a \$1000 Donation to the person who has given the plants, he will also grow seedlings for the next year's planting. 100 Totara, Kawaka and Kowhai trees are being sourced for \$713 for planting next year.
